CLP Smart Energy Award Attracts More than 700 Entries as Businesses and Organisations Use Innovation to Promote Low-carbon Transformation and Tackle Climate Change

CLP Power Hong Kong Limited (CLP Power) today (24 October) organised a presentation ceremony for the 2024 Smart Energy Award, recognising businesses and organisations for their outstanding performance in energy management, application of innovative energy-saving solutions, and renewable energy development. The programme, which promotes the adoption of innovation to reduce emissions and help Hong Kong move towards carbon neutrality, attracted entries from more than 700 corporate and government bodies, small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs), non-governmental organisations (NGOs), and educational institutions.

Awards were presented in three categories: Carbon Management, Innovation, and Energy Management. Each category comprised a division for corporate and government bodies and another for catering firms, SMEs, NGOs, educational institutions, and property management companies. Judges selected a total of 65 winners (please see appendix for full award list). The energy-saving and carbon reduction solutions implemented by this year's winning businesses and organisations will collectively save approximately 67 gigawatt hours (GWh) of electricity, equivalent to the annual electricity consumption of 20,000 households.

CLP Power Chief Corporate Development Officer Ms Quince Chong said, "CLP Power has been enhancing the resilience of our power supply system to address the challenges of extreme weather and maintain our supply reliability. At the same time, we provide our customers with support to enhance their preparedness in the face of extreme weather. The Smart Energy Award was established to encourage businesses and organisations to make good use of innovative technologies to further improve their energy-saving and carbon reduction performance, alleviate the impact of climate change, and work together towards the goal of carbon neutrality by 2050."

The ceremony's officiating guest Energy Advisory Committee Chairman Professor Simon Wong said, "Decarbonisation requires concerted efforts from all sectors of the

society. The encouraging response to the CLP Smart Energy Award shows that more and more enterprises are making energy-saving and emission reduction a business focus. I hope all industries will continue to work towards the goal of carbon neutrality while seizing the business opportunities brought by low-carbon transformation, promoting the sustainable development of enterprises, Hong Kong, and the nation.”

The ceremony marked the seventh year of the Smart Energy Award programme which is widely recognised by the society and has a judging panel comprising officials and experts, including representatives from the government, business chambers, green groups, and professional bodies.

The innovative carbon reduction solutions of winning entries are showcased at the CLP Smart Energy Award award-presentation ceremony, including the Hospital Authority, which won the Energy Management Grand Award for adopting an energy management database system for automated monitoring of the energy use of facilities (photo 4), and the winners of the Carbon Management Excellence Award, Wing Nin Store has introduced a system to manage the electricity consumption of its cooking equipment and air-conditioning system by means of mobile electronic devices (photo 5) and Kai Shing Management Services Limited which enhanced the efficiency of its air conditioning system in the shopping malls by leveraging artificial intelligence technology and retro-commissioning (photo 6).
