CLP Power has teamed up with Po Leung Kuk to operate the **CLP Hotmeal Canteens** in Sham Shui Po, Kwun Tong, and Kwai Tsing districts, providing dietician-supervised hot meals to elderly people, low-income families and people in financial difficulties at nominal cost. The **Canteens** has served over 1.1 million nutritious hot meals to the community since launched in 2011.
